Environmental protection

The trail passes through sensitive and protected natural areas. Participants agree to stay on marked trails, not to leave any litter behind, and to respect local flora and fauna.

Route changes and cancellation

The organizers reserve the right to change the course or cancel the event entirely or in part due to adverse weather, force majeure, or safety concerns. In such cases, there is no entitlement to a refund of the entry fee.
